



KAREN GIBBONS-BROWN | ARTISTIC DIRECTOR



#### CYNTHIA PRATT GUEST CHOREOGRAPHER PROFESSOR OF DANCE, BUTLER UNIVERSITY

Cynthia Pratt, Professor of Dance, has been a member of the dance faculty at Butler University since 1994. She received her B.A. degree in Ballet from Virginia Intermont College in 1979 and her M.F.A. degree from Temple University in 1989. In between undergraduate and graduate school, Cynthia lived in New York City where she trained extensively in jazz dance with world-renowned teacher Lynn Simonson,

who became her mentor. While in New York, she began teaching Simonson Technique and choreographing on a commission basis for repertory dance companies. Cynthia has a wide range of performing experiences both in the United States and Europe in ballet, modern, and jazz companies as well as on television and in musical reviews with Jon de Mal Productions in Amsterdam. Cynthia has taught jazz dance and choreographed extensively at such institutions as the North Carolina School of the Arts, New York University, Steps, Philadanco, the National Balletacademie Theatre School in Amsterdam, the Goteborg Balletakademien in Goteborg, Sweden, the National Taiwan University of the Arts and Dance Space Center in New York. She has worked as an auditioner for the Jacob's Pillow Summer Dance Festival Jazz Project and has served as artistic director for several choreographic showcases established to exhibit the work of new choreographers at Evolving Arts in New York. In addition, Cynthia is a Certified Movement Analyst and holds a degree from the Laban Institute for Movement Studies. Since relocating to Indianapolis, Cynthia has choreographed many works for the Butler Ballet and has frequently worked as Guest Choreographer for Dance Kaleidoscope, Indiana's premier modern dance company. She continues to teach and choreograph on companies and in universities throughout the U.S and abroad. Cynthia is the recipient of numerous research and choreographic grants including being twice awarded the prestigious Indianapolis Arts Council Creative Renewal Grant, given to established and noteworthy artists in Indiana. Since 2004, Cynthia has been Artistic Director for Butler Chamber Dance, an innovative performing wing of the Butler Ballet Company. Under Cynthia's direction, Butler Chamber Dance has performed at the Indianapolis Spirit and Place Festival, Penrod Arts Festival, Hope College, Wabash College and with Dance Kaleidoscope.

Since 2009, Cynthia has been experimenting with large-scale, site-specific dances (between 100-500 participants) and from 2012 through 2016 was the choreographer for Streamlines, a project funded by the National Science Foundation which explored the use of the arts to raise awareness of concerns of local waterways. Her experiences in choreographing these large-scale works, and the impact they have had on community building, was published in 2017 in *The Oxford Handbook of Dance and Well-Being*.



#### KAREN GIBBONS-BROWN ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Karen Gibbons-Brown's resume contains an impressive list of credentials. She began her early training in Columbia, South Carolina under Ann Brodie, Naomi Calvert and Adolphina Suarez-More. Her early training and performing included ballet as well as modern, jazz, tap and theater dance. She continued her studies at American Ballet Theatre with Maria Swoboda, Michael Lland, Patricia Wilde and Leon Danelian and studied on scholarship at David Howard School of Ballet.

Her professional experiences also include South Carolina Chamber Dance Ensemble, Ballet Celeste, Bristol Ballet and the Theatre Ballet of San Francisco where she recreated Anna Pavlova's roles The California Poppy and The Dragonfly. Other performing highlights include performances at the Spoleto Festival in Charleston, South Carolina, the title role in *Cinderella*, The Sugar Plum Fairy in *The Nutcracker*, Swanhilda in *Coppelia*, Aurora in *The Sleeping Beauty* and "Spring Waters" pas de deux, an exciting display of partnering created by the great Russian choreographer Asaf Messerer. Ms. Gibbons-Brown considers herself fortunate to have had works created especially for her including solos, *Pentimento* by Jill Eathorne Barr and the role of Anna in Richard Monroe's work, *The Hussar*. Throughout her career, she has made numerous guest appearances throughout the United States.

Ms. Gibbons-Brown is known for her work in the classroom and enjoys teaching a variety of dance related subjects including ballet, pointe, repertoire, terminology, dance history, pedagogue and makeup and hair for stage as well as restaging major classical works. She has often been invited to teach guest classes and workshops including in Sicily, Italy, Fontenay le Fleury, France and the prestigious Joffrey San Antonio Workshop under the directorship of her mentor Jeremy Blanton. She received her certification in Labanotation while serving on the faculty of Virginia Intermont College under the direction of Constance Hardinge and served as Ballet Mistress for John McFall as he created his production of The Nutcracker for Atlanta Ballet. In 1985, Ms. Gibbons-Brown founded the Kingsport Guild of Ballet and became Artistic Director of the State of Franklin Dance Alliance at its inception in 1988. Other dance administrative duties include serving on the Tennessee Association Board of Directors in many capacities including as president and serving on the Performing Arts Panel for the Tennessee Arts Commission. She assumed directorship of Fort Wayne Ballet in August of 1998. Other career highlights include Outstanding Dance Artist Award in 1997, serving as a juror for Concours International de Danse Classique in Paris, France in 2000, a 2002 graduate of Leadership Fort Wayne and being listed in Who's Who in the 21st Century. In 2010, a new book authored by renowned choreographer Dean Speer, entitled On Technique, identifies Ms. Gibbons-Brown as among the world's 18 most respected ballet masters, pedagogues and artistic directors. Karen is currently involved with the ABT training curriculum and has been certified though level 5.

Her other full time job is spending time with her husband, Jim, and children Watson, Madison, Hannah, Zachary, Raleigh and a sundry of dogs.
