Auer Academy of Fort Wayne Ballet 2023-2024 Tuition Policy

Tuition is based on a 36 week academic year, (August-May). **Academy classes are curricular and are not taken** "monthly" or "per class." Your student's registration fee reserves their place in class for the academic year.

FEE INFORMATION

- A <u>non-refundable registration fee of \$50</u> is required at the time of registration to secure class placement each year. Any additional children enrolling within the same immediate family pay \$20.00. Registration fees include a continuing education opportunity.
- There must be a valid credit card on file for all accounts.
- All families opting for Plan B or C must have a currently valid credit card number on file with Fort Wayne Ballet in the event a payment is not received by the 1st of the month. Fort Wayne Ballet will submit the charge to the credit card on the 10th of the month in the event of non-receipt of payment.
- A \$25 service fee will be added to all returned checks and invalid or declined credit cards.
- <u>Family tuition discount</u>: The student with the highest tuition rate pays full tuition, a second immediate family member enrolled in Academy classes will receive a 10% discount on his/her tuition, all third or more subsequent, immediate family members enrolled in Academy classes will receive a 20% discount on tuition.
- If tuition payment policies are a hardship for you, contact Fort Wayne Ballet's Academy Registrar, Raleigh Sparrow, at rsparrow@fortwayneballet.org to work out a mutually beneficial payment arrangement. Limited work study/scholarship opportunities are available. Please check with Raleigh Sparrow for scholarship/work study information.
- In the event that an account is 2 months in arrears, the student(s) will not be able to participate in classes. Once the account is up-to-date, they may return.
- Accounts must be paid in full by May 1, 2024 in order to participate in the End of Year Showcase. (April 1, 2024 for senior students.)

EARLY WITHDRAWAL

- Auer Academy of Fort Wayne Ballet offers a pro-rated tuition refund for students who withdraw from classes due to illness or injury, supported by a doctor's statement.
- Tuition payments are required until Fort Wayne Ballet is notified in writing of cancellation.
- Withdrawals due to extenuating family circumstances will be reviewed on a case by case bases and tuition may be pro-rated and withdrawal a fee may be assessed.

SCHEDULE CHANGES

- Make-up lessons due to sickness, out-of-town trips, school functions etc. are strongly encouraged and must be made up within the current academic year. Please consult the Parent-Student Handbook for the appropriate make-up class.
- Academy of Fort Wayne Ballet reserves the right to cancel classes due to inadequate registration and will help place students in appropriate classes.
